ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS

To be eligible for a Minnesota Power New Generation Scholarship, you must be...

- Enrolled fulltime at a qualifying college or university (see list)
- Pursuing a Bachelor Degree or Associate Degree in a qualifying field of study (see list)
- Entering your junior or senior year of a Bachelor Degree program OR final year of an Associate Degree program next fall
- Maintaining a cumulative college GPA of at least 3.0

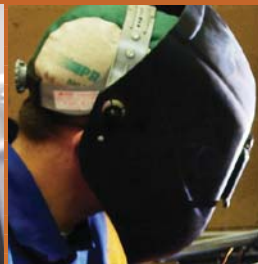

In addition to the completed application form, please enclose a copy of your official college transcript and letters of recommendation from at least two of the following: instructor, academic advisor or employer.

AWARDS

Bachelor Degree Scholarships: **\$2,000**

Associate Degree Scholarships: **\$1,000**

Total scholarships awarded will not exceed \$50,000 annually.

Awards will be announced in early May and recipients will be recognized at a banquet. The award is copayable to the institution and the recipient. Scholarships are not renewable.

DETERMINATION OF AWARDS

Awards will be determined based on the number of applications received and applicants' demonstrated and articulated commitment to completing degrees at qualifying institutions in fields of study that match regional workforce needs. Members of the selection committee are totally independent and separate from Minnesota Power, Minnesota Power Foundation and ALLETE, and no employee or former employee of these organizations will select recipients of the Minnesota Power New Generation Scholarship.
