- **Recycle** the heat in your home to cool it in the summer and benefit the environment.
- **Reduce, Reuse and Recycle** to provide heating, cooling and water heating in one easy-to-use system.



How do I take advantage of the Incentive Package and start achieving the benefits of GSHP?

1. You must work with a program participating International Ground Source Heat Pump Association (IGSHPA) accredited contractor. Visit www.mnpower.com/gshp for a list of program participating IGSHPA accredited contractors and more information on GSHPs and the Incentive Package. Each contractor must complete a pre-application, which is reviewed by a third party before a rebate application is approved.
2. Your contractor will meet with you to determine if a GSHP is right for you. He or she will properly install the GSHP based on your expectations and explain how to operate and maintain it for optimum performance beyond energy savings. Remember to ask for the rebate on the ECM motor and the information required to qualify for the federal tax credit. **Note:** Make sure your contractor installs a program qualifying GSHP that meets federal tax credit requirements and also talk with your accountant about how to qualify for the tax credit.
3. Your contractor will complete all the required paperwork and attach this coupon and submit it to Minnesota Power for review and processing. Please allow 6–8 weeks for your rebate. This rebate offer is good through June 30, 2012. Some restrictions apply.
